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Alejandro J. Valella, Vice President and Deputy Counsel of the Agencies, acted as Secretary and asked for motions and seconds to call the meetings to order of the Audit Committees of the New York State Housing Finance Agency (“HFA”), the State of New York Mortgage Agency (SONYMA), the New York State Affordable Housing Corporation (“AHC”), the State of New York Municipal Bond Bank Agency (“MBBA”) and the Tobacco Settlement Financing Corporation (“TSFC”).

Elaine McCann made a motion to call the AHC and HFA meetings to order; Committee Chairman Mulholland seconded the motion. Elaine McCann made a motion to call the SONYMA meeting to order; Mr. Bergamo seconded the motion; Elaine McCann made a motion to call the MBBA meeting to order; Mr. SanFilippo seconded the motion. Elaine McCann made a motion to call the TSFC meeting to order; Mr. SanFilippo seconded the motion.

Mr. Valella noted that as items are presented to each Committee throughout the meetings, these motions and seconds will be used, unless specific items call for a different vote, or unless any Committee member wishes to record his or her vote differently.

The meetings of the Audit Committees were opened in joint session for the consideration of various matters of shared importance. These minutes reflect only those items being considered by the Directors of the State of New York Municipal Bond Bank Agency Audit Committee. A record of items considered by the other Agencies' Audit Committees is contained in the minutes of each Committee respectively.

Mr. Valella noted that Elaine McCann was participating in the meeting by video conference from the New York State Division of Budget conference center at the Capital Building, Room 143, in Albany and that Mr. SanFilippo was participating via video conference from the Agency's offices in Buffalo, New York. A public notice was given of the time and locations of both venues.

The first item on the agenda was the approval of the minutes of the State of New York Municipal Bond Bank Agency 28th Audit Committee Directors' meeting held on April 4th, 2012.

The next item on the agenda was a report on Whistleblower Policy. Directors were referred to a discussion of this item that had occurred earlier in the day at a meeting of the Governance Committee that had been attended by the Directors of the MBBA Audit Committee and asked that presentation of this item be waived.

Elaine McCann moved to adopt the following resolution; Mr. SanFilippo seconded the motion and the following resolution was unanimously adopted.

Stephen Chohey, Vice President- Internal Audit Group, presented on this item and explained that the Audit Committee charter requires that the Audit Committee approve internal audit follow-up audit report of 2010. Mr. Chohey further highlighted certain information contained in the materials provided to the Directors in connection with this item, which are incorporated herein by reference.

Elaine McCann moved to adopt the resolution; Mr. SanFilippo seconded the motion; and the following resolution was adopted unanimously:
