Between June 19, 1997 and June 23, 2011 the DRT was \$2000.

Between June 24, 2011 and June 14, 2015 the DRT was \$2500.

Between June 15, 2015 and December 31, 2015 the DRT was \$2700.

Westchester \$2,830.21 (\$2,803.86 if tenant pays for heat or hot water)

Between July 1, 1998 and June 30, 2011 the DIT income was \$175,000.
